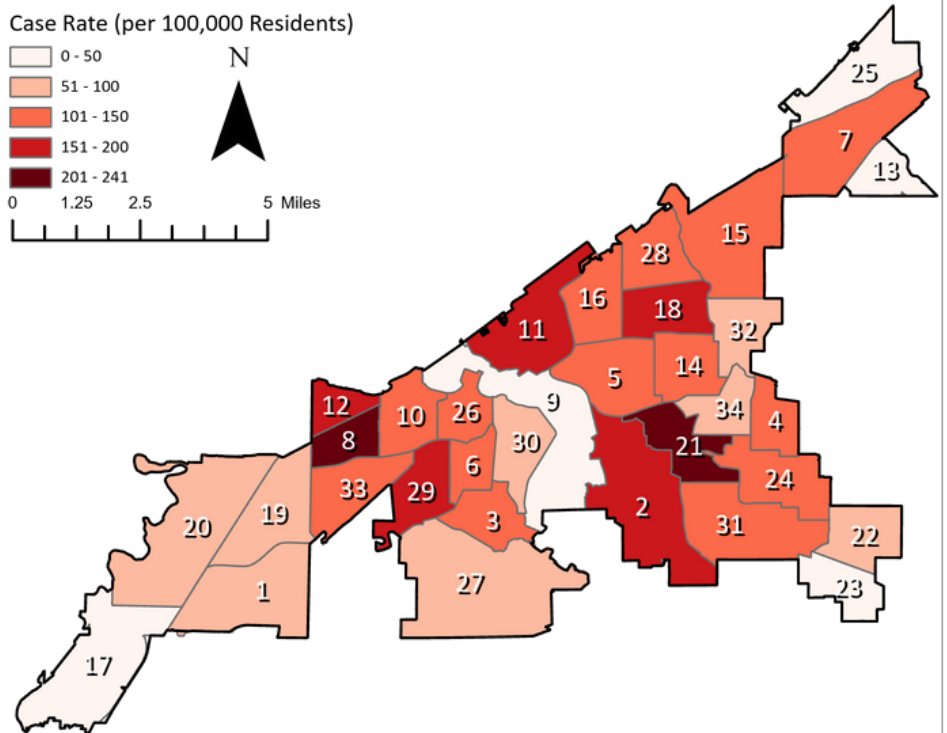
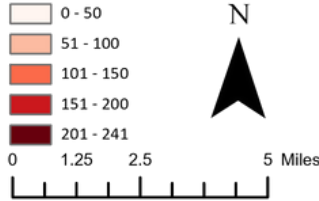

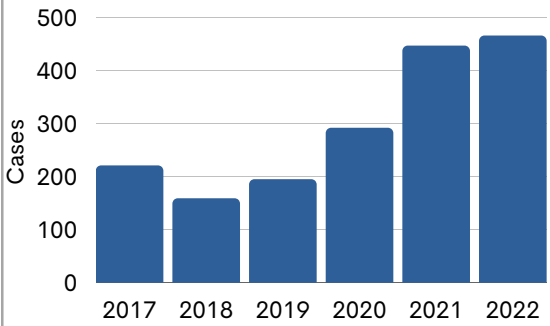
CASE RATE BY NEIGHBORHOOD

Case Rate (per 100,000 Residents)

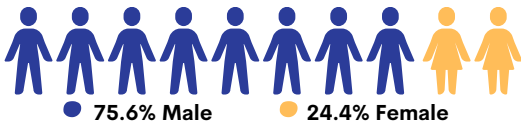

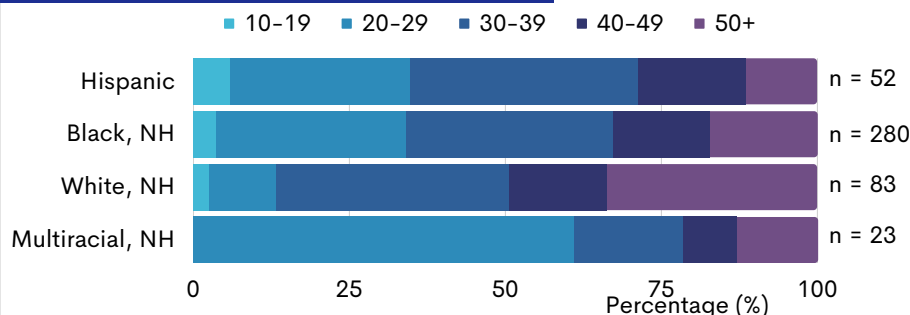

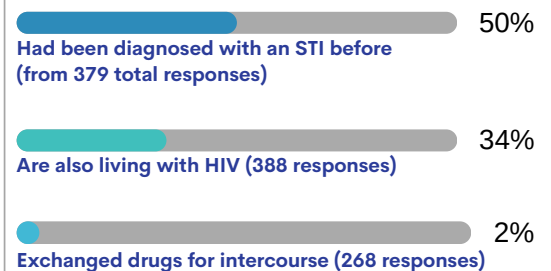
