

Prescription Delivery Services – as of March 25th, 2020

In order to protect those most vulnerable against COVID-19, some pharmacies have implemented free prescription delivery programs. Currently, pharmacies with such policies include:

CVS:

- Free 1-2 day delivery until May 1st
- Sign-up online (<https://www.cvs.com>) or via the mobile app
 - When prescription is ready, you will receive a text message with delivery options. Click the link included in the text message to order your prescription delivered.
- Will be delivered via national delivery service, such as USPS
- Controlled substances and/or refrigerated medications may not be eligible for delivery
- Contact your local pharmacy with questions or for more information

Rite Aid:

- Tuesday and Wednesday delivery, call 24 hours in advance
- Can order prescriptions via telephone – contact your local Rite Aid to order
- Controlled substances and/or refrigerated medications are not eligible for delivery
- Contact your local pharmacy with questions or for more information

Sheliga Drug:

- Free delivery Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
- Call (216) 431-1035 and ask for Joe to place an order

Walgreens:

- Free express delivery
 - Order before 4:00 pm Monday – Friday to receive delivery next day
 - Sign-up online (<https://www.walgreens.com>) or via the mobile app
 - When prescription is ready, you will receive a text message with delivery options. Click the link included in the text message to order your prescription delivered.
- Free standard online shipping
 - Order prescriptions online (<https://www.walgreens.com>) and select the “Ship to you”
 - Will arrive in 5-10 business days
