Current Season Summary:

November 24 – November 30, 2019 MMWR Week 48

This week there were 148 emergency department visits for influenza-like illnesses out of 5,867 total visits to emergency departments; there were 4 hospitalizations for influenza occurred this week; and, there were 10 pneumonia or flu related deaths out of 222 total deaths this week. Only one of the three indicators, influenza-like illnesses, was elevated to a *very high* threshold this week. Therefore, the seasonal flu intensity remains *Low*.

Flu activity this week was minimal and remains at low intensity












Influenza-Like Illnesses



The proportion of Emergency Room visits for influenza-like illnesses was elevated to the *very high* threshold. This week 53% of visits were among males. Regarding race and ethnicity, 29% of visits were Black or African American individuals; 17% were among White or Caucasian individuals; and more than a third (37%) of visits were among Other racial groups. About one third (30%) of visits were among Hispanic or Latino individuals. The median age was 4 years.


Hospitalizations



There have been 7 hospitalizations related to influenza to-date. The majority (71%) of these are Influenza B-related. Data are preliminary and subject to change as more information is gained.

Pneumonia- & Influenza-Associated Deaths*



The proportion of deaths due to pneumonia or influenza-related (P&I) illnesses is still within the *low* threshold this week. Of all P&I deaths that have occurred this season, all are associated with pneumonia and not influenza.

All P&I deaths that occurred this week were among individuals age 45 and older. To-date, only 2 P&I deaths have occurred among younger age groups, specifically within those 25-44 years of age.
