



The Respiratory Report summarizes influenza, COVID-19, and Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) activity in the City of Cleveland during each week of respiratory illness season. Respiratory illness season starts at the beginning of October (MMWR week 40) and lasts until mid-May the following year (MMWR week 20).*

Week 42 Summary

- 1.1% of emergency department (ED) visits were for influenza-like illness (ILI) plus fever.
- There was 1 hospitalization for COVID reported this week. Hospitalization and death data often experience a delay in reporting, so more data for this week may appear on future reports.
- CDPH is investigating 1 COVID-19 outbreak in a congregate care setting.
