The purpose of the annual *Syphilis Profile* is to summarize the yearly 2017 cases of Syphilis in the City of Cleveland and surrounding area. *Please note that reported annual data may change due to delayed submissions and additional laboratory results.*


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Current Year (2017):

- 285 newly diagnosed cases of Syphilis in Cleveland, OH
- The number of new cases increased by 23% compared to 2016
- 43% of new cases in Cleveland were among young adults between the ages of 20 and 29 years of age

Previous Year (2016):

- 232 newly diagnosed cases of Syphilis in Cleveland, OH
- The number of new cases increased by 65% compared to 2015


