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The purpose of the COVID-19 Watch is to summarize the coronavirus surveillance in the City of Cleveland, Ohio. This summary report reflects the period starting from February 15, 2020 until July 30, 2022.

What Matters Most

1. Cleveland COVID-19 cases increased during the week of July 24th with 812 new cases and a rate of 212 new cases per 100,000 residents. The true number of cases is likely much greater than is reported here, due to the fact that positive home tests are not being reported to the health department. If you test positive for COVID-19 using an at-home test kit, please report the result to the Cleveland Department of Public Health at 216-664-3747.
2. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Cuyahoga County continues to have a COVID-19 Community Level of *high* as of July 29th. Consider mitigation measures such as masking in public or holding gatherings outdoors whenever possible in order to minimize community spread.
3. This past week, 153 residents received their first COVID-19 vaccine. Overall, 48.8% of Cleveland residents have completed a primary vaccination series (two doses of Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech OR one dose of Johnson & Johnson) and 24.2% received their booster shot. Receiving all recommended doses of the vaccine ensures that you have the best protection against severe illness, hospitalization, and death. Adults ages 50 and older are eligible for a second booster dose.
4. CDPH is now offering COVID-19 vaccinations for children ages 6 months and up at both J. Glen and McCafferty Health Centers. Starting your child's vaccination series now can ensure they have the best protection against COVID-19 when they return to school in the fall. 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*Final cause of death can take weeks to determine and so the number of deaths in the previous weeks are subject to change as more information is reported from ODH.

**Vaccine data were exported from the DataOhio Portal on August 2, 2022. Vaccination summaries include vaccinations administered to Cleveland residents by any supplier. In CDPH data reporting, individuals are counted in every group of which they meet the criteria. For example, a Cleveland resident who has completed a primary series and received a booster will be included in the counts of each group. Please note, the criteria to have "Completed a Primary Series" differs for individuals who are moderately to severely immunocompromised.

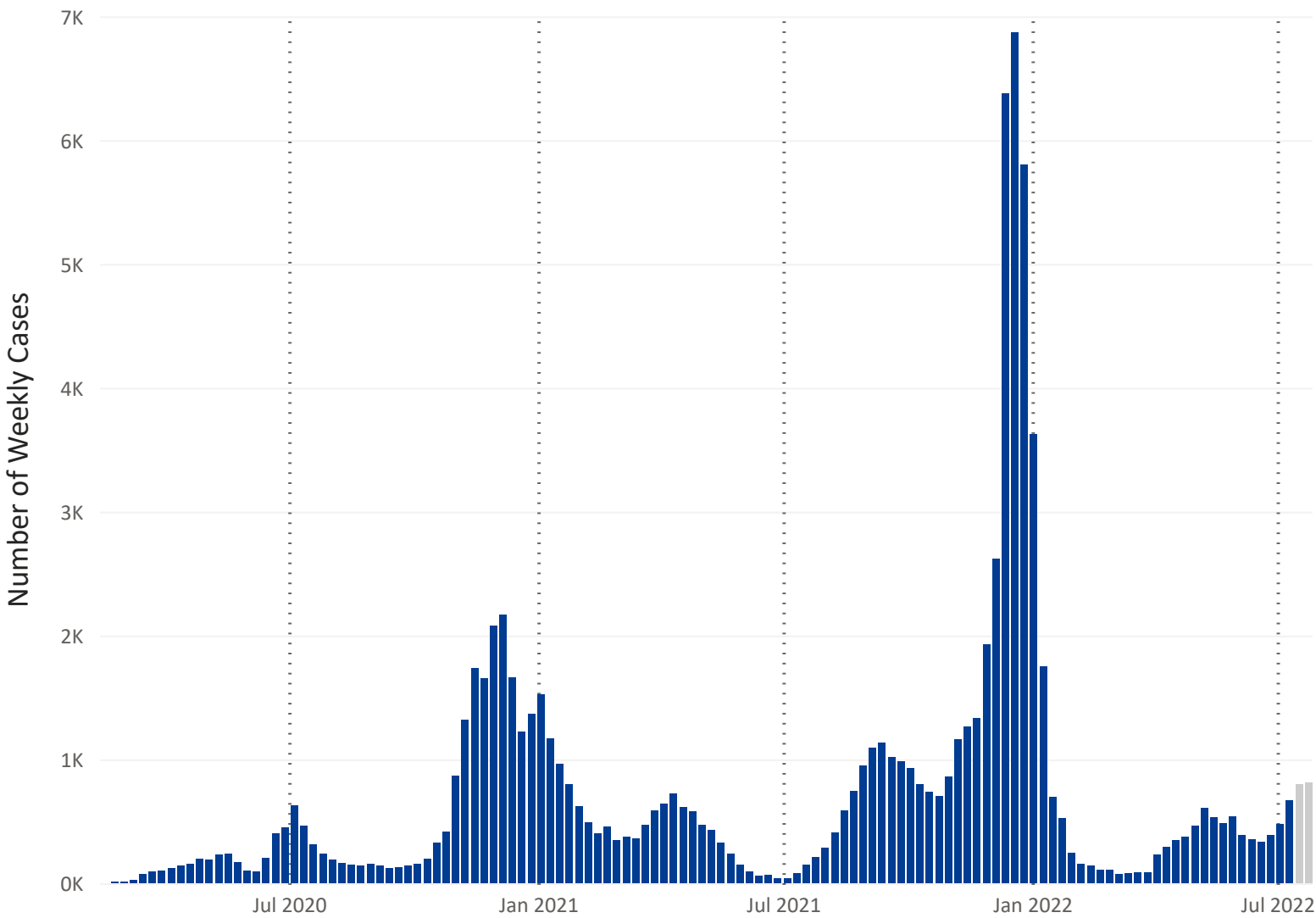


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Total Cases by Specimen Collection Date as of July 30, 2022

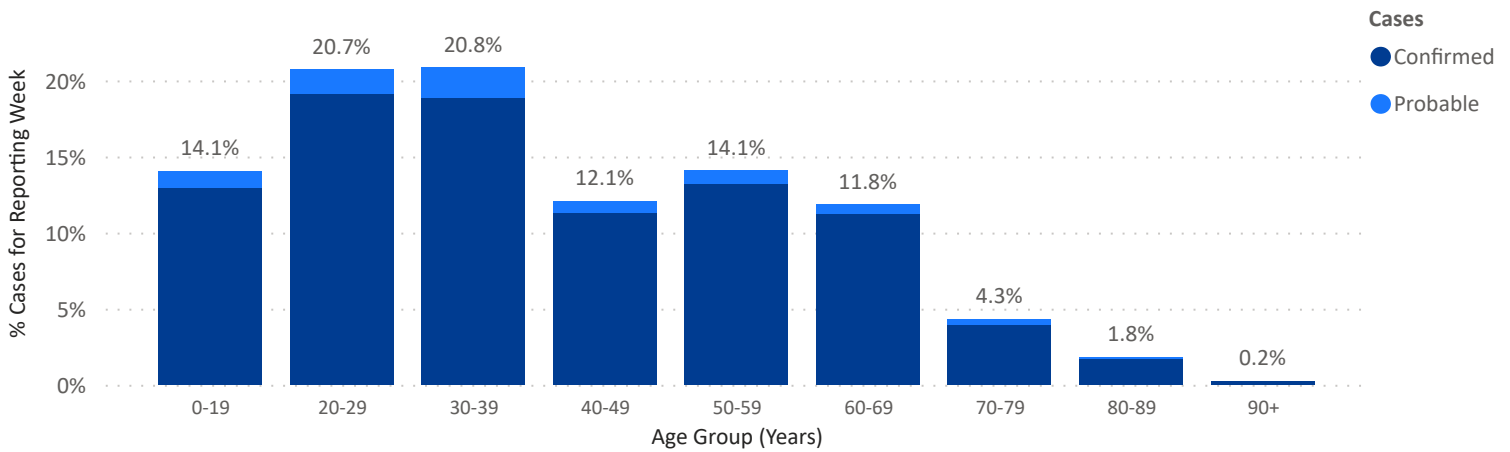


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Cases by Age Group

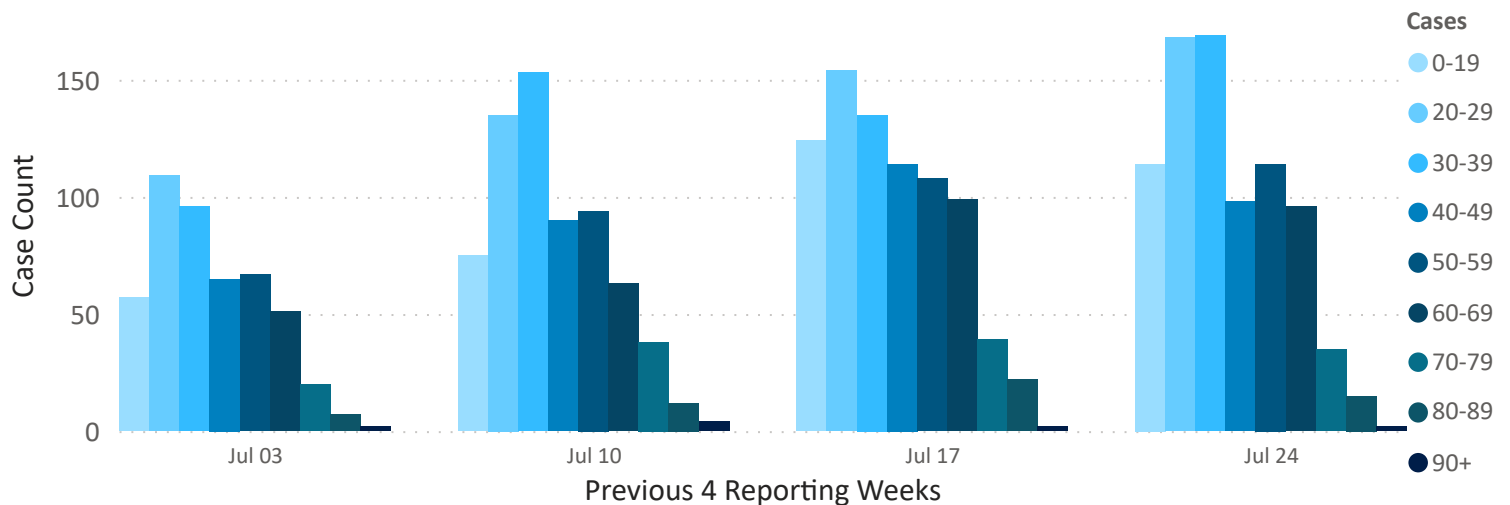

Figure 4. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Gender (Jul 24, 2022 - Jul 30, 2022) (based on 810 cases)

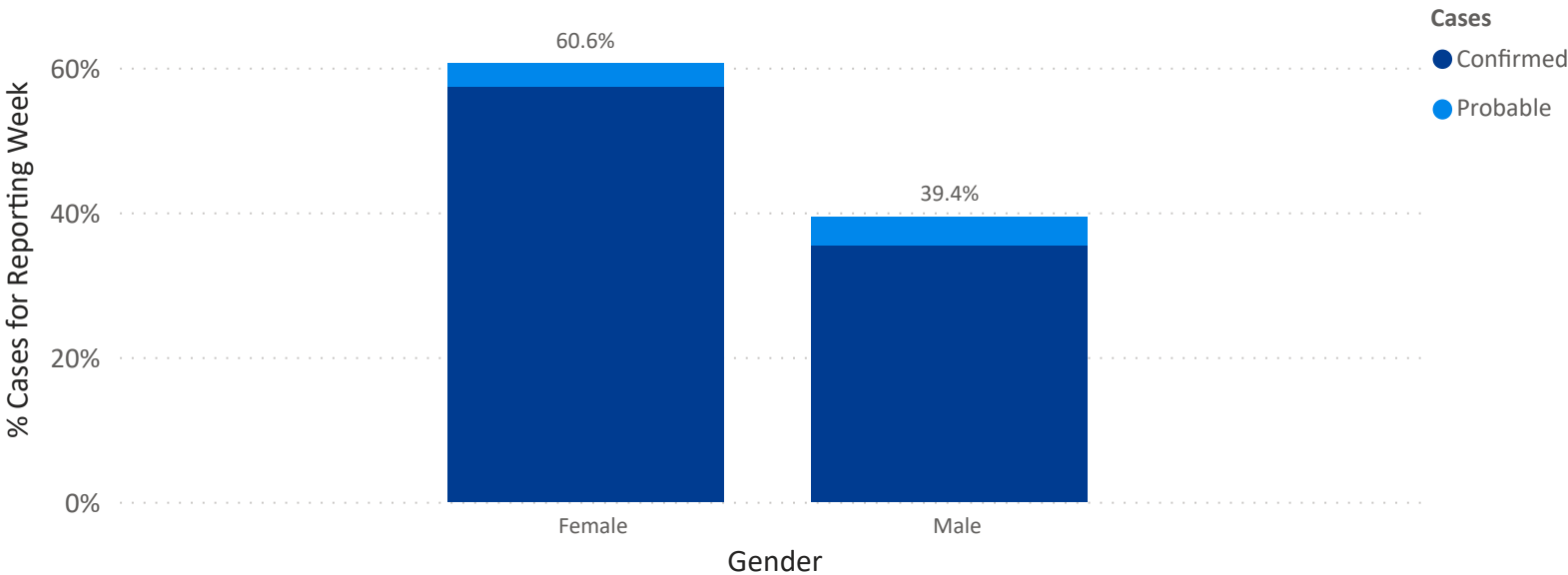
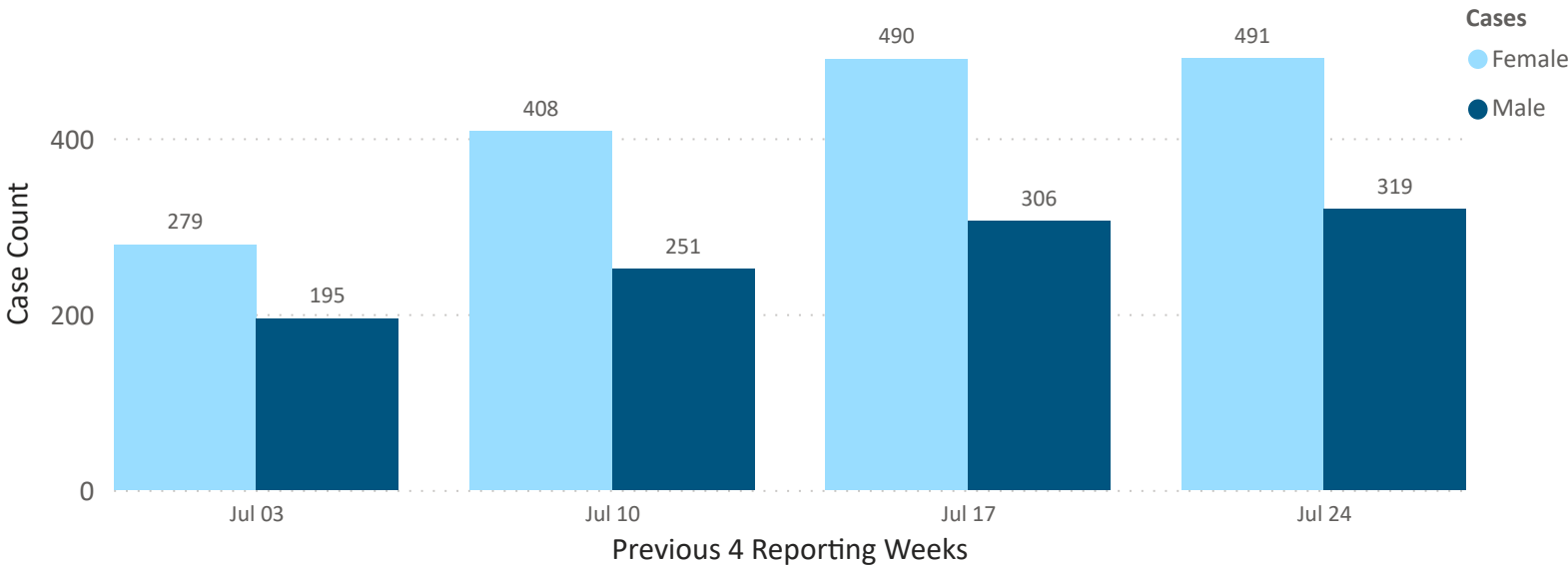


Figure 5. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Gender (Jul 03, 2022 - Jul 30, 2022) (based on 2,739 cases)

Figure 6. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Race (Jul 24, 2022 - Jul 30, 2022) (based on 706 cases)

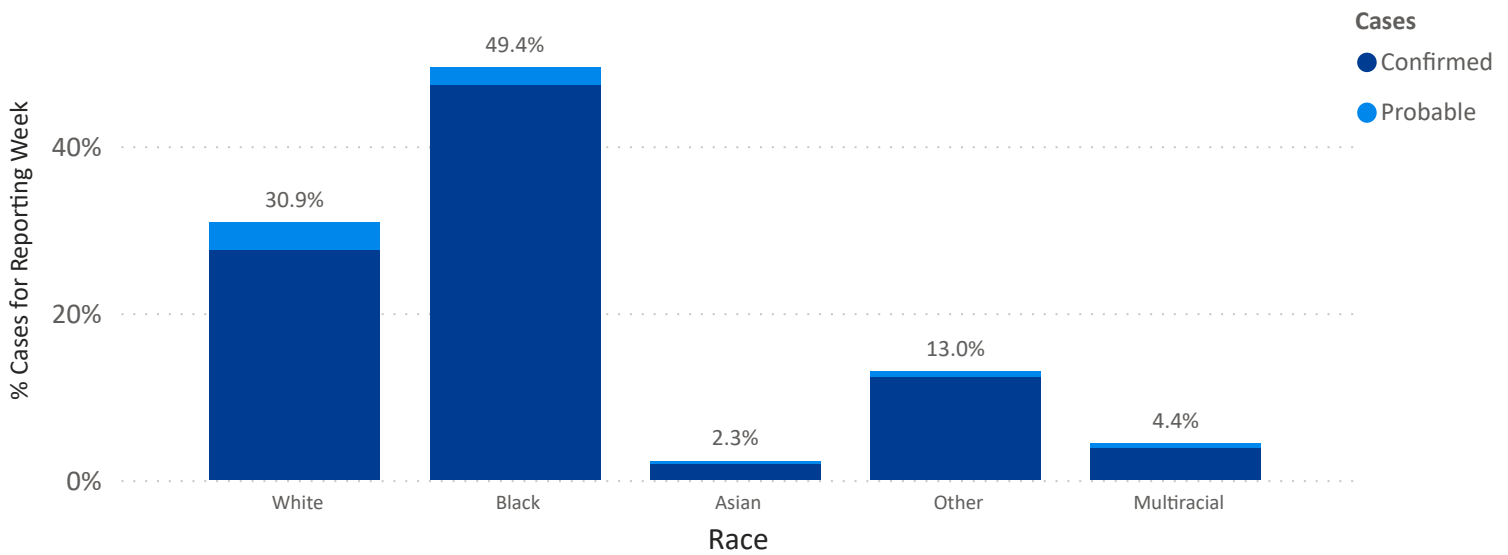
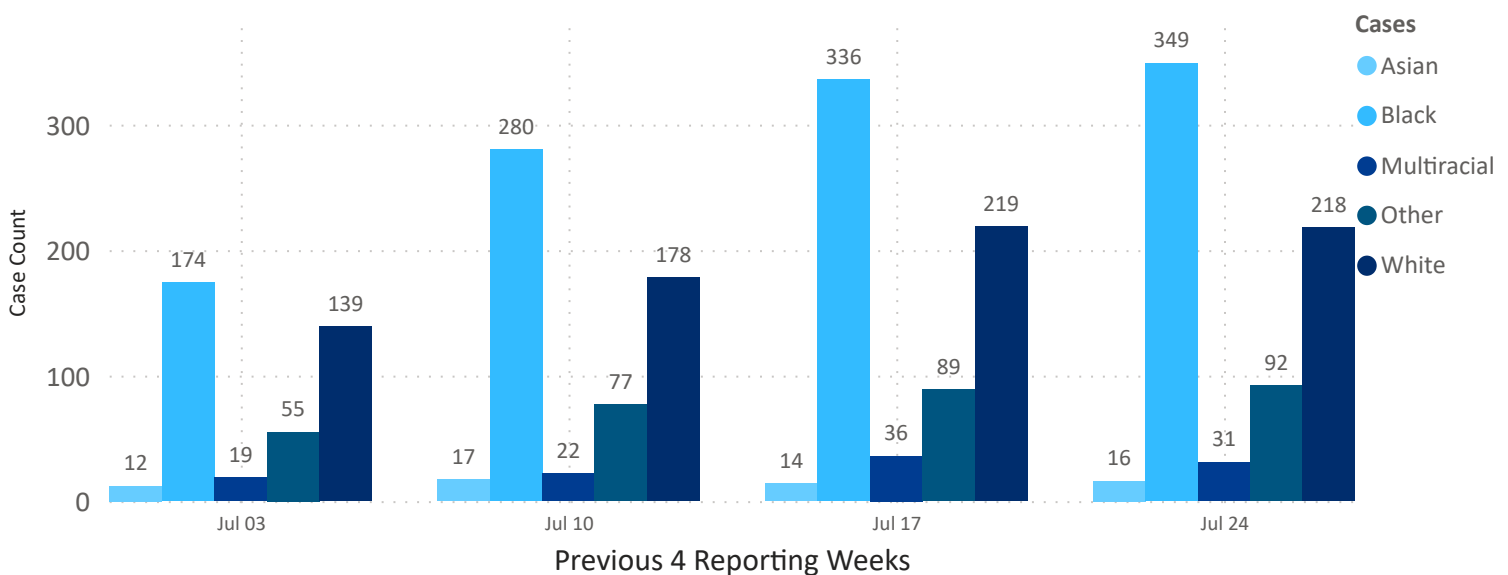


Figure 7. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Race (Jul 03, 2022 - Jul 30, 2022) (based on 2,373 cases)

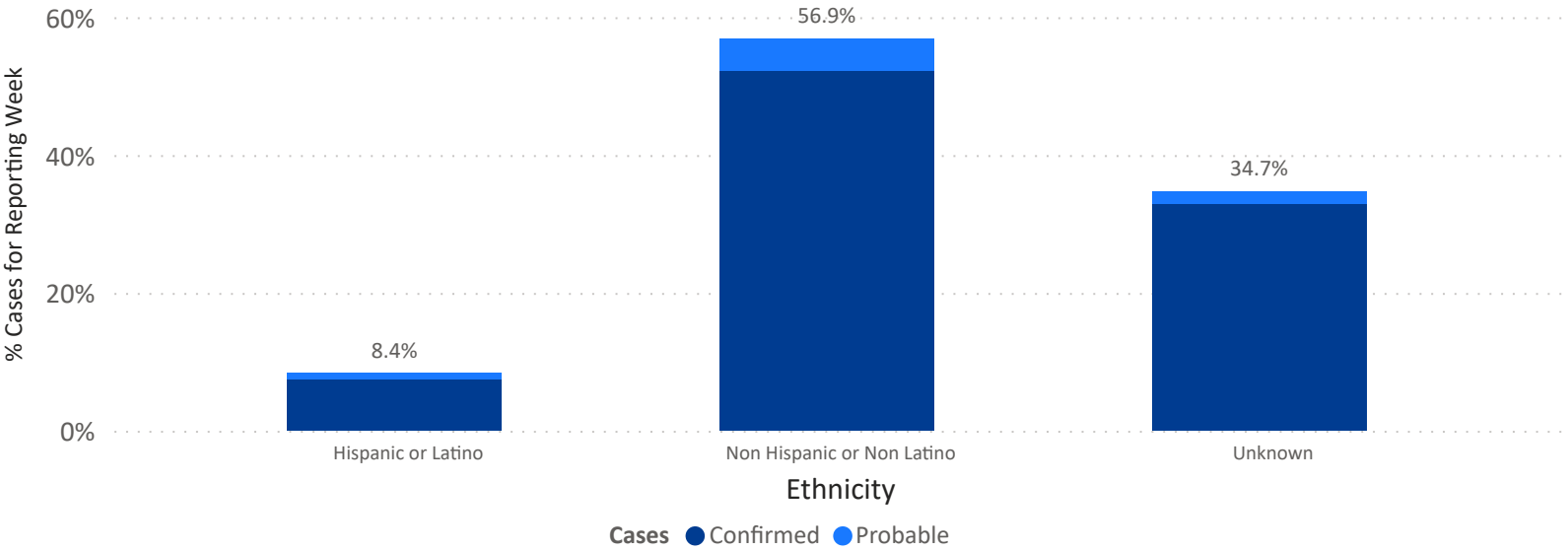
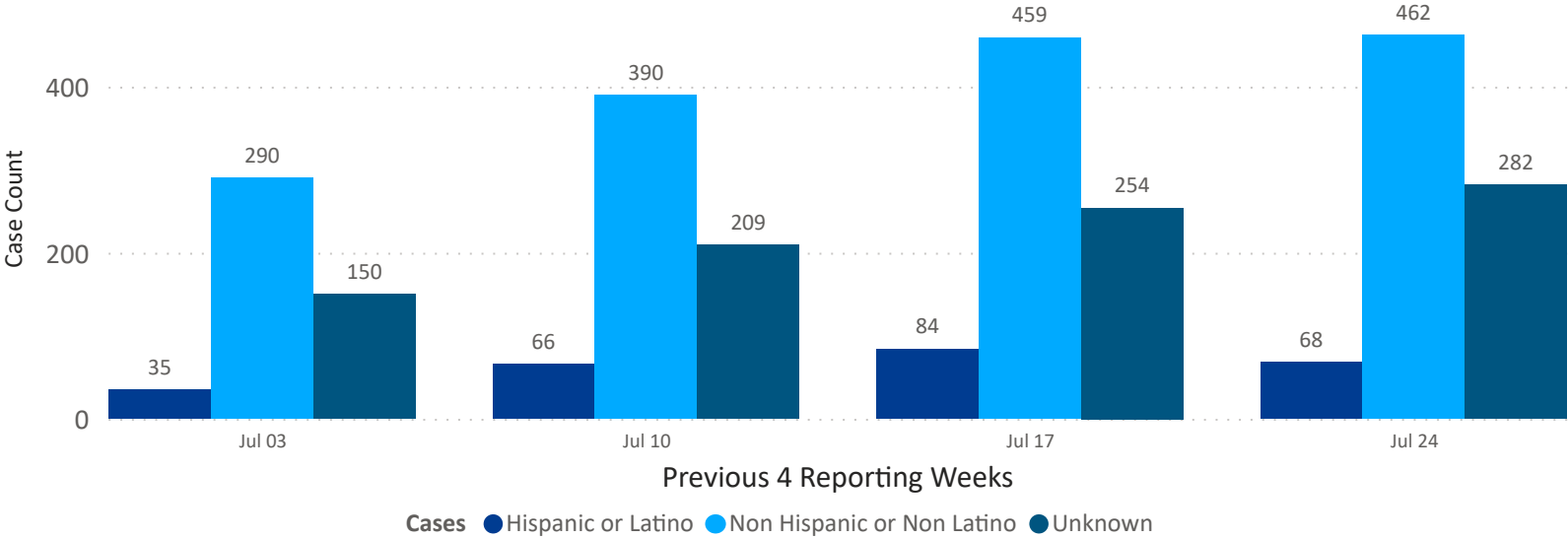


Figure 9. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Ethnicity (Jul 03, 2022 - Jul 30, 2022) (based on 2,749 cases)





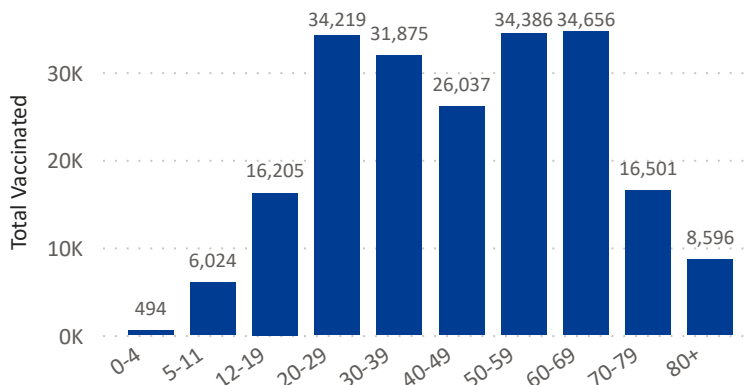
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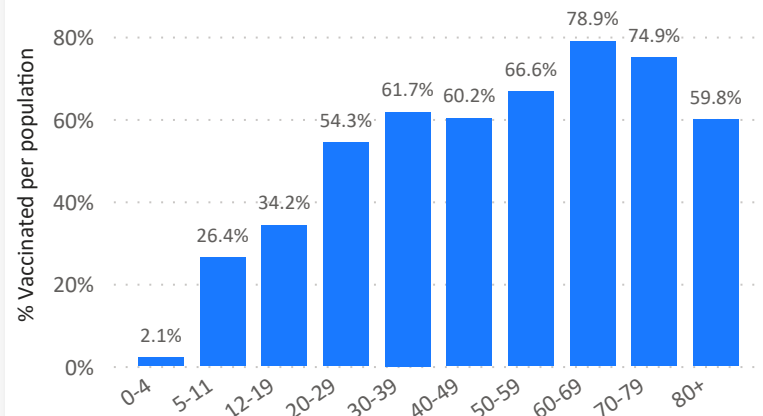

Number of Vaccinated Cleveland Residents by Age Group (based on 208,993 residents)

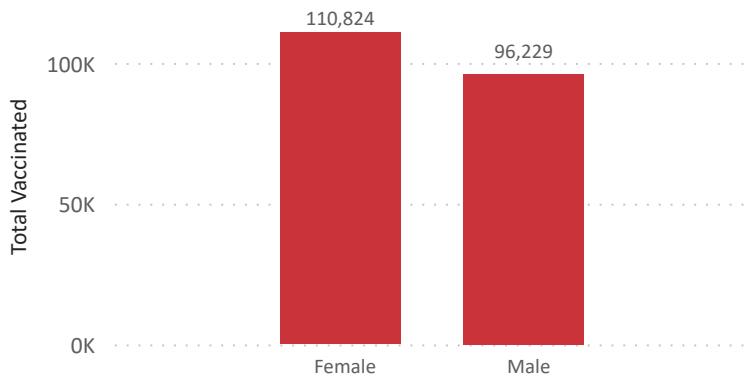


% of Cleveland Residents Vaccinated per Age Group

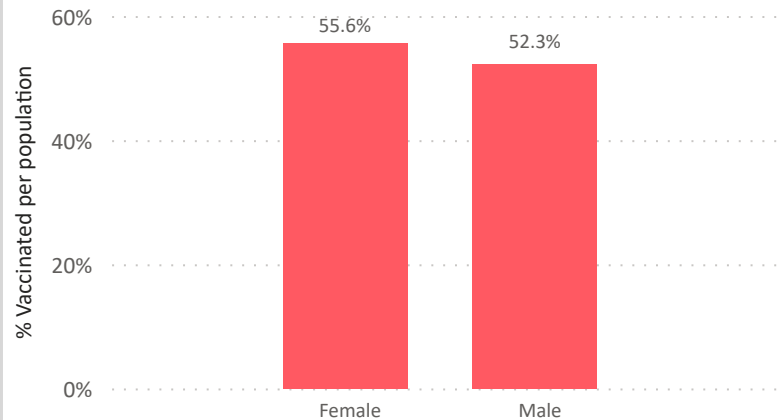

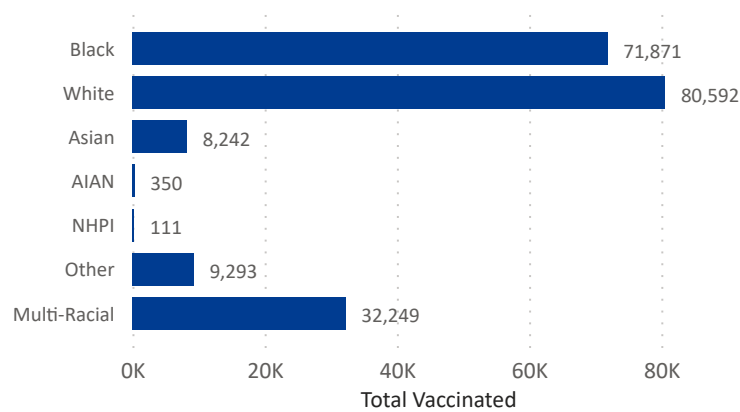
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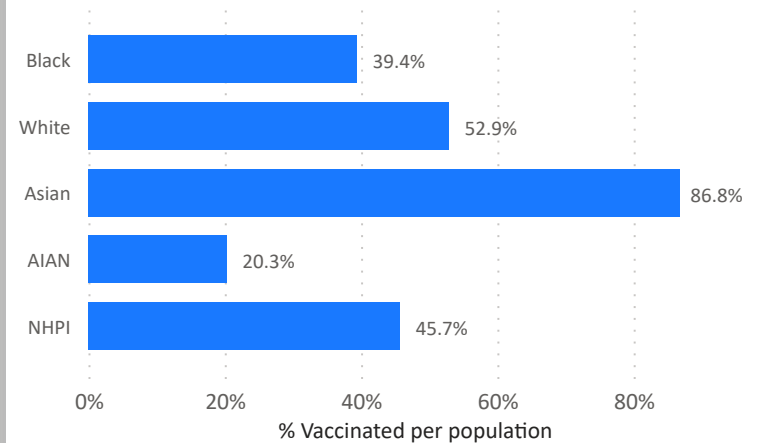

Number of Vaccinated Cleveland Residents by Race (based on 202,708 residents)

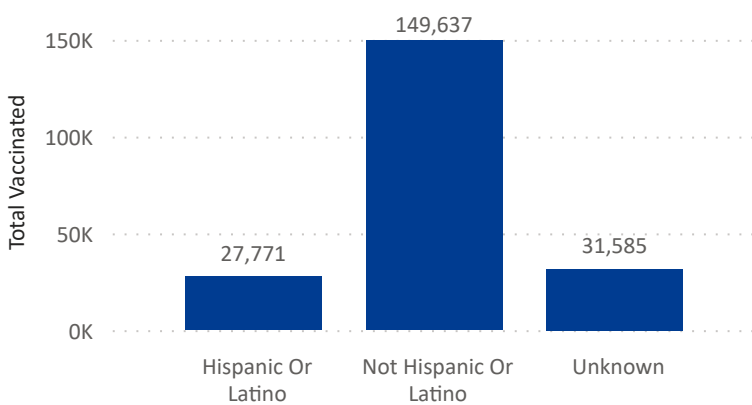


% of Cleveland Residents Vaccinated per Race Population

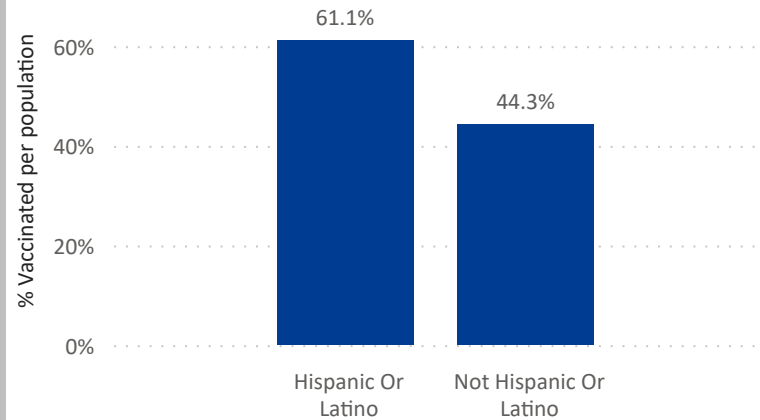

% of Cleveland Residents Vaccinated per Ethnicity



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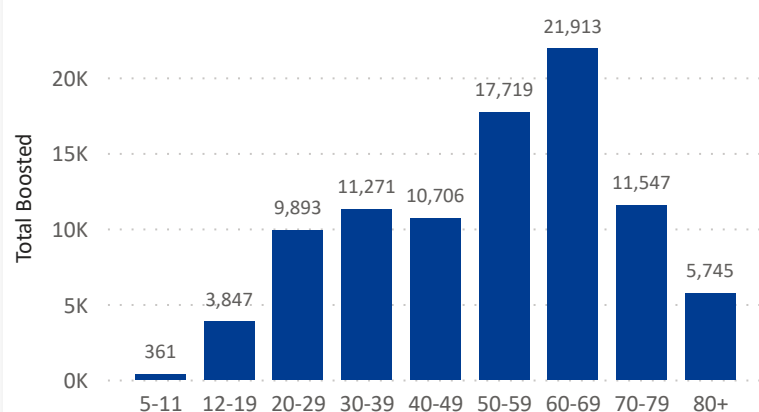
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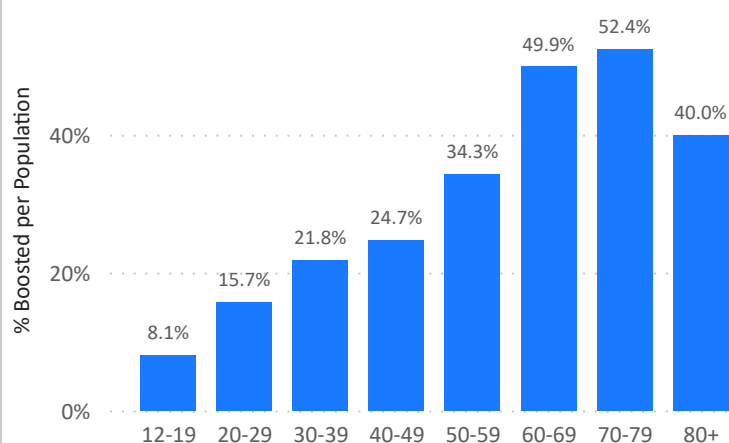

Number of Boosted Cleveland Residents by Age Group (based on 93,002 residents)

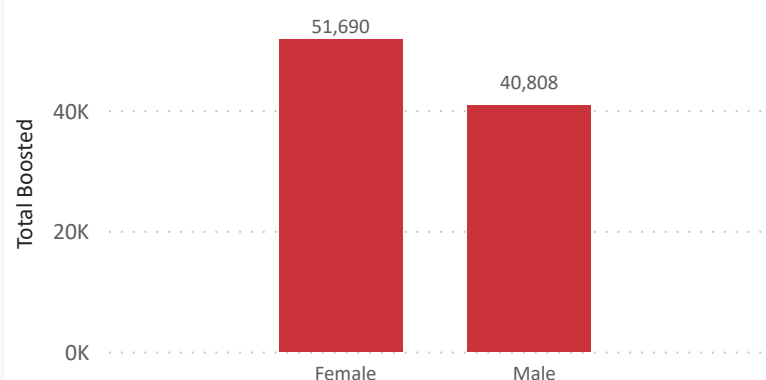


% of Cleveland Residents Boosted by Age Group

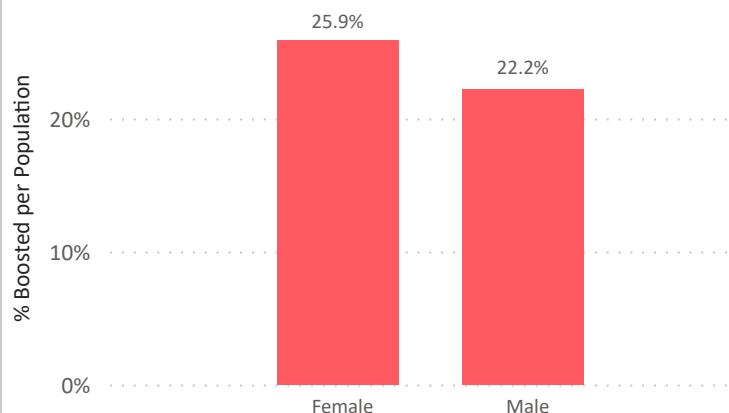

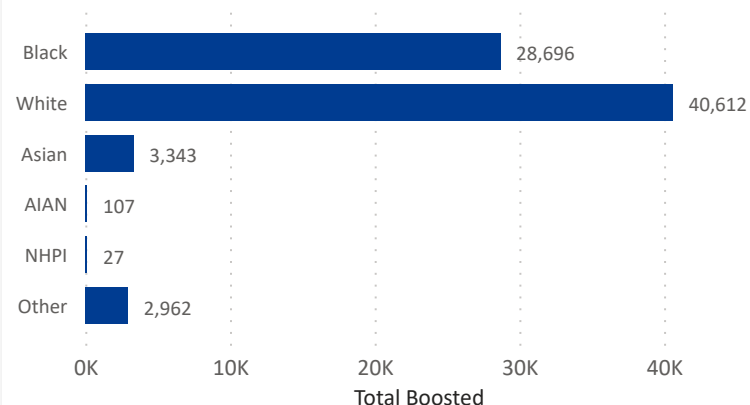
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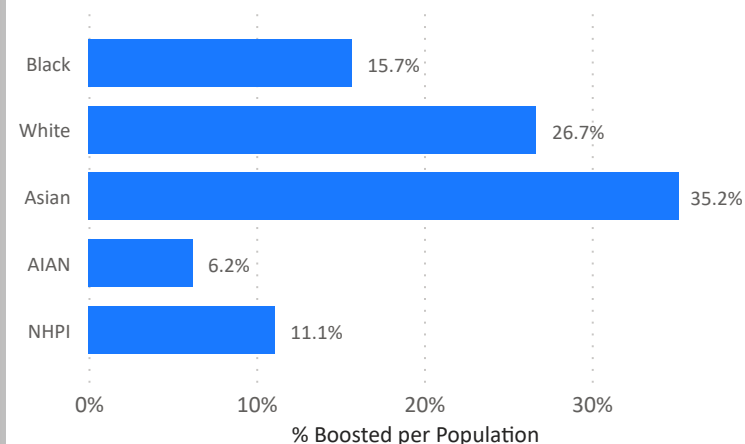

Number of Boosted Cleveland Residents by Race (based on 75,747 residents)

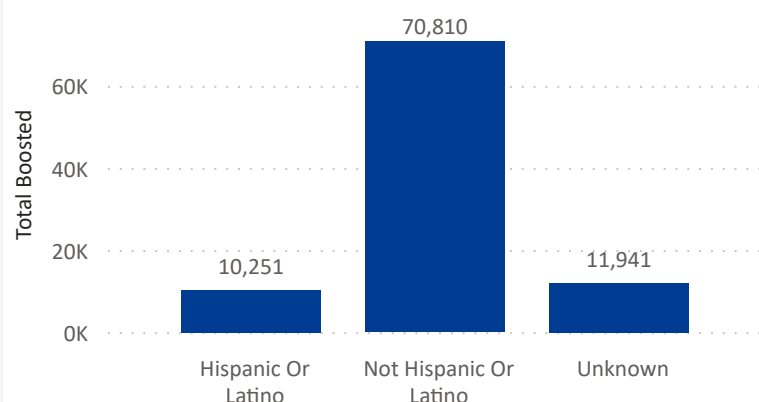


% of Cleveland Residents Boosted per Race Population

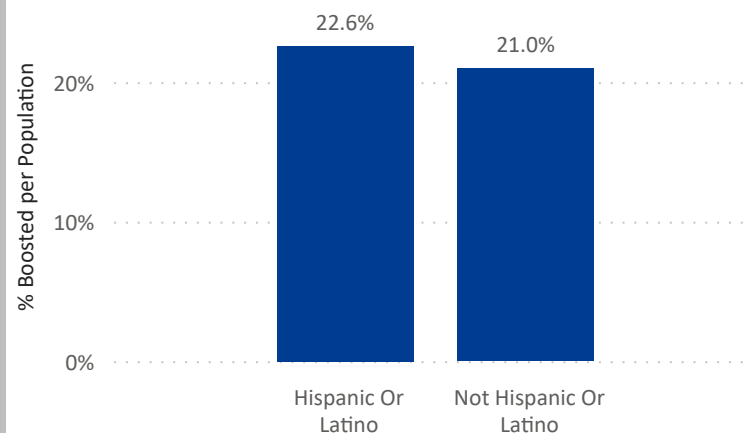

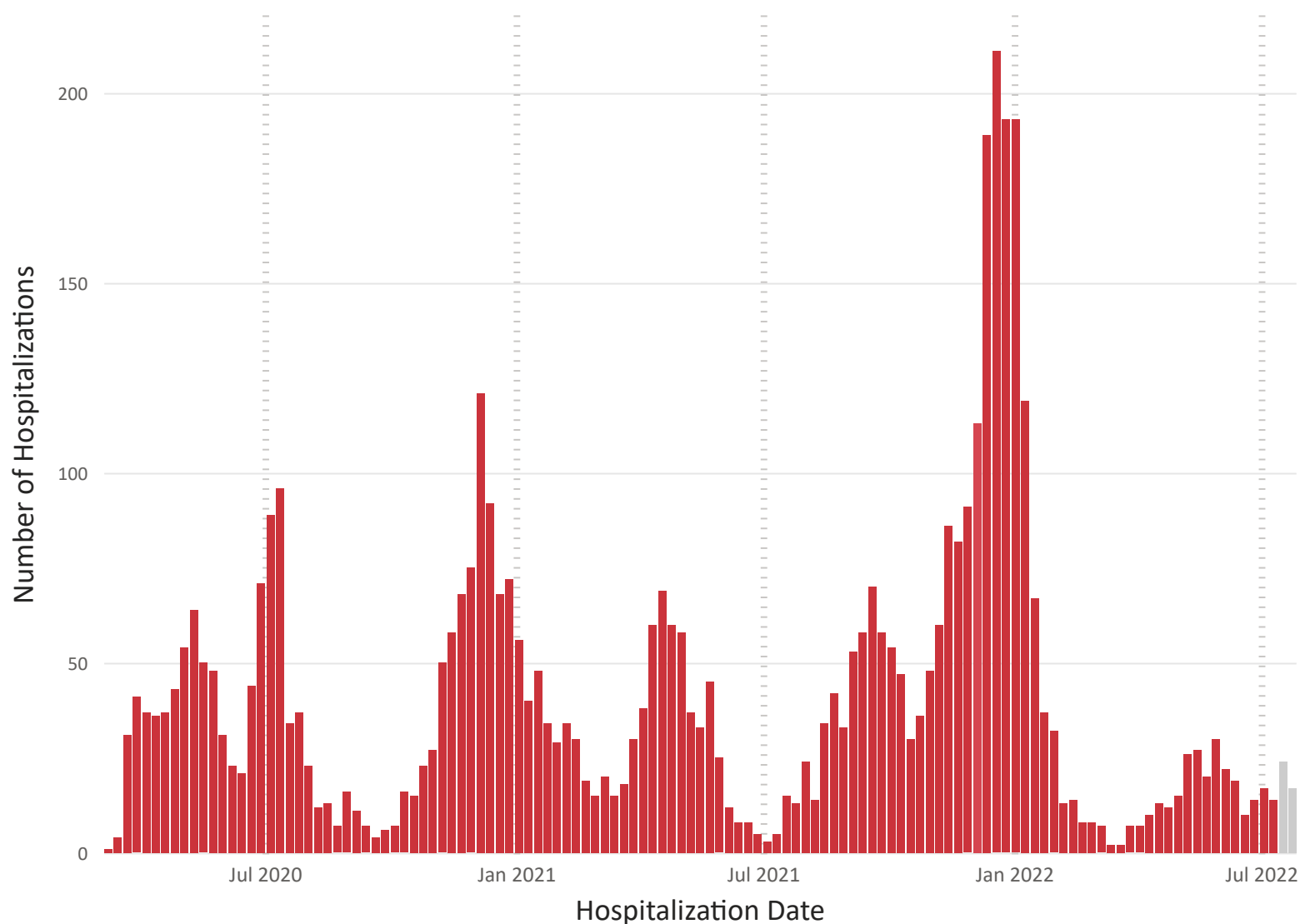


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Hospitalization by Admission Date

Note: Figure 10 does not include 387 cases for whom hospital admission date is unknown and 1 case with an admission date prior to February 15, 2020.



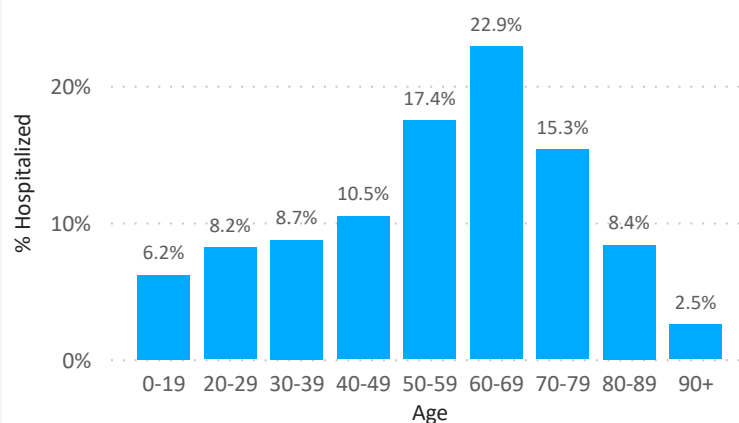
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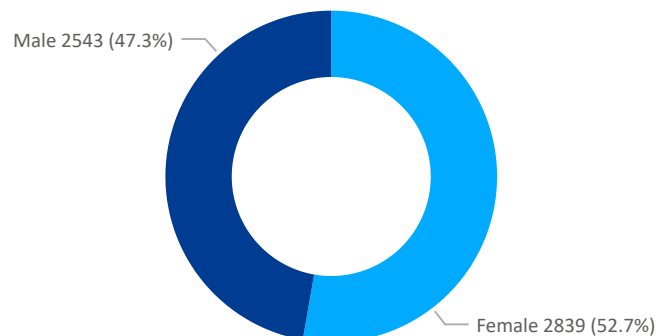

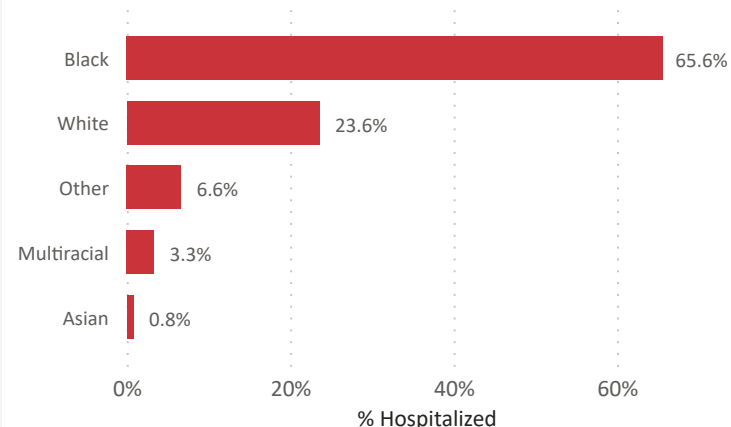

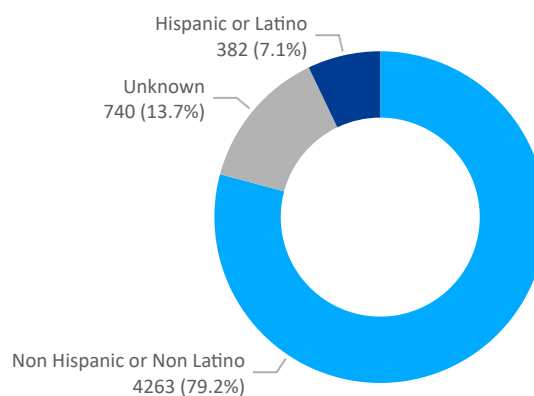

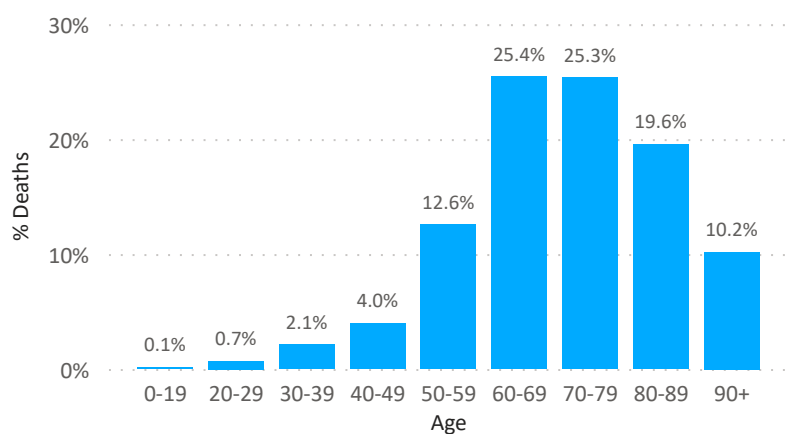
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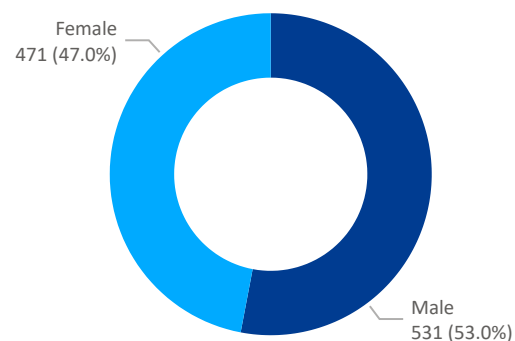

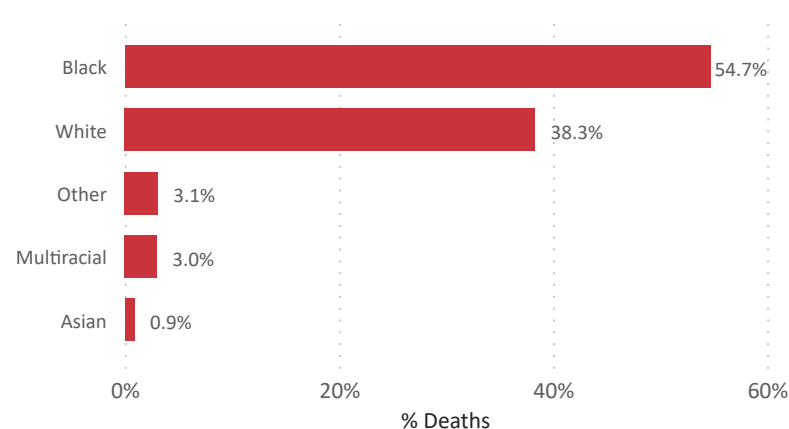

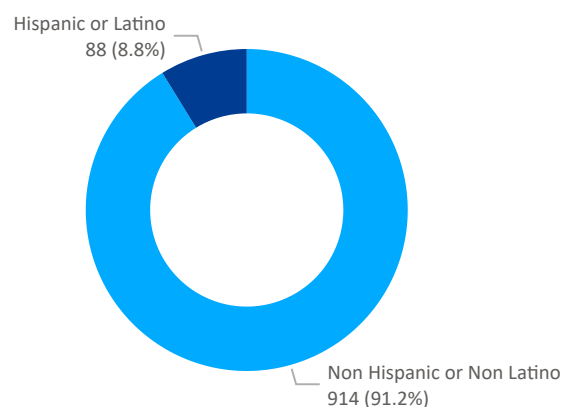

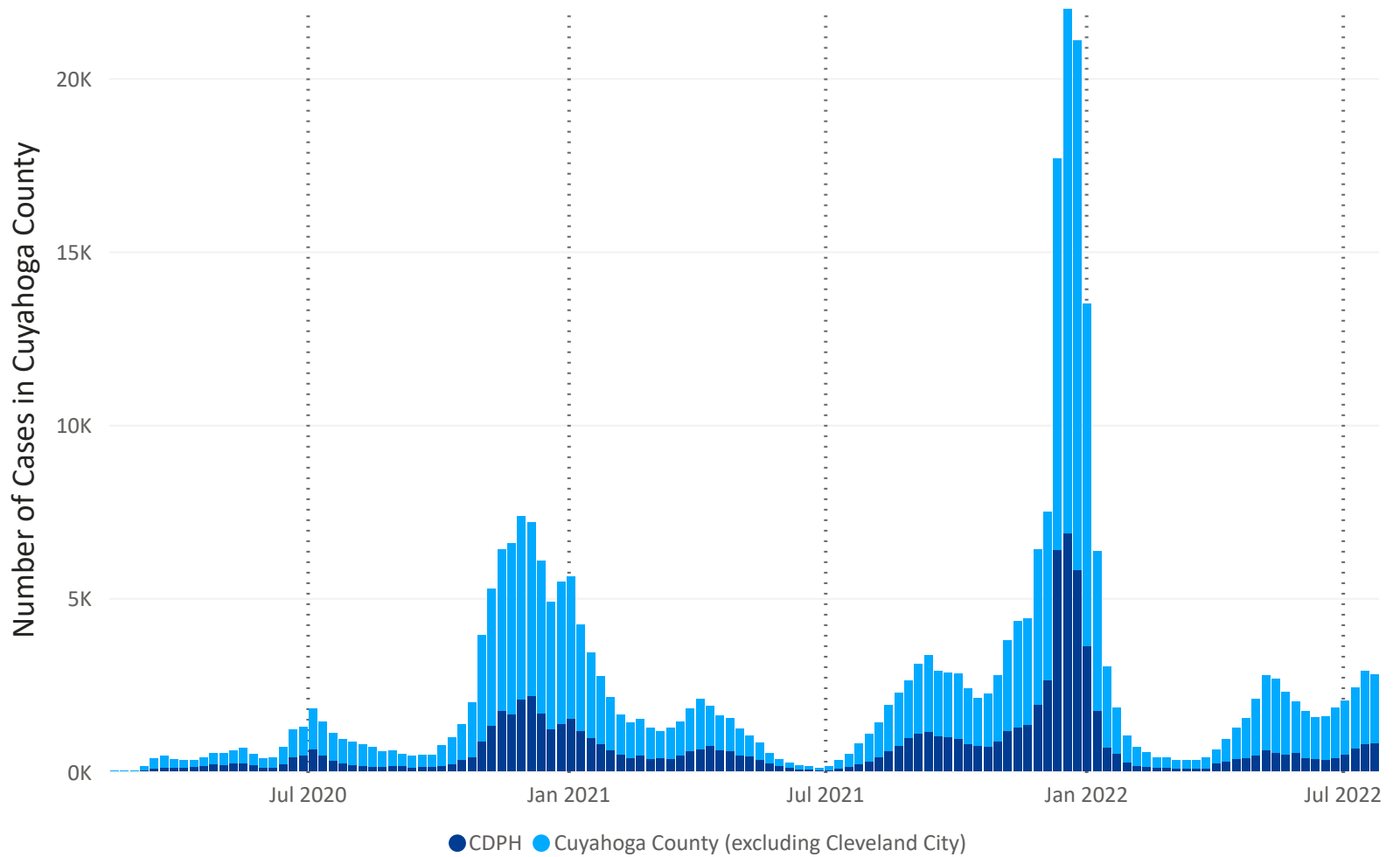

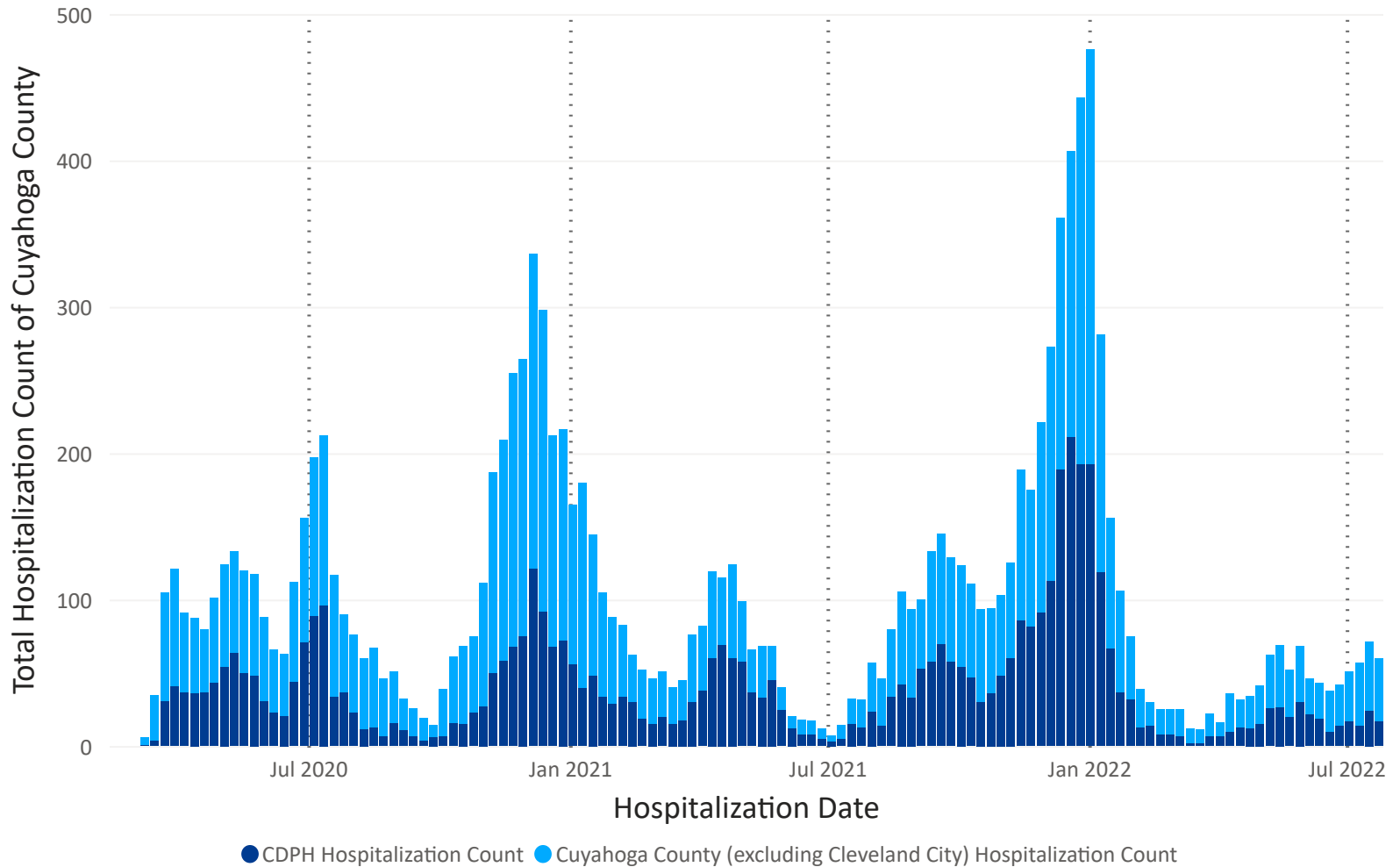

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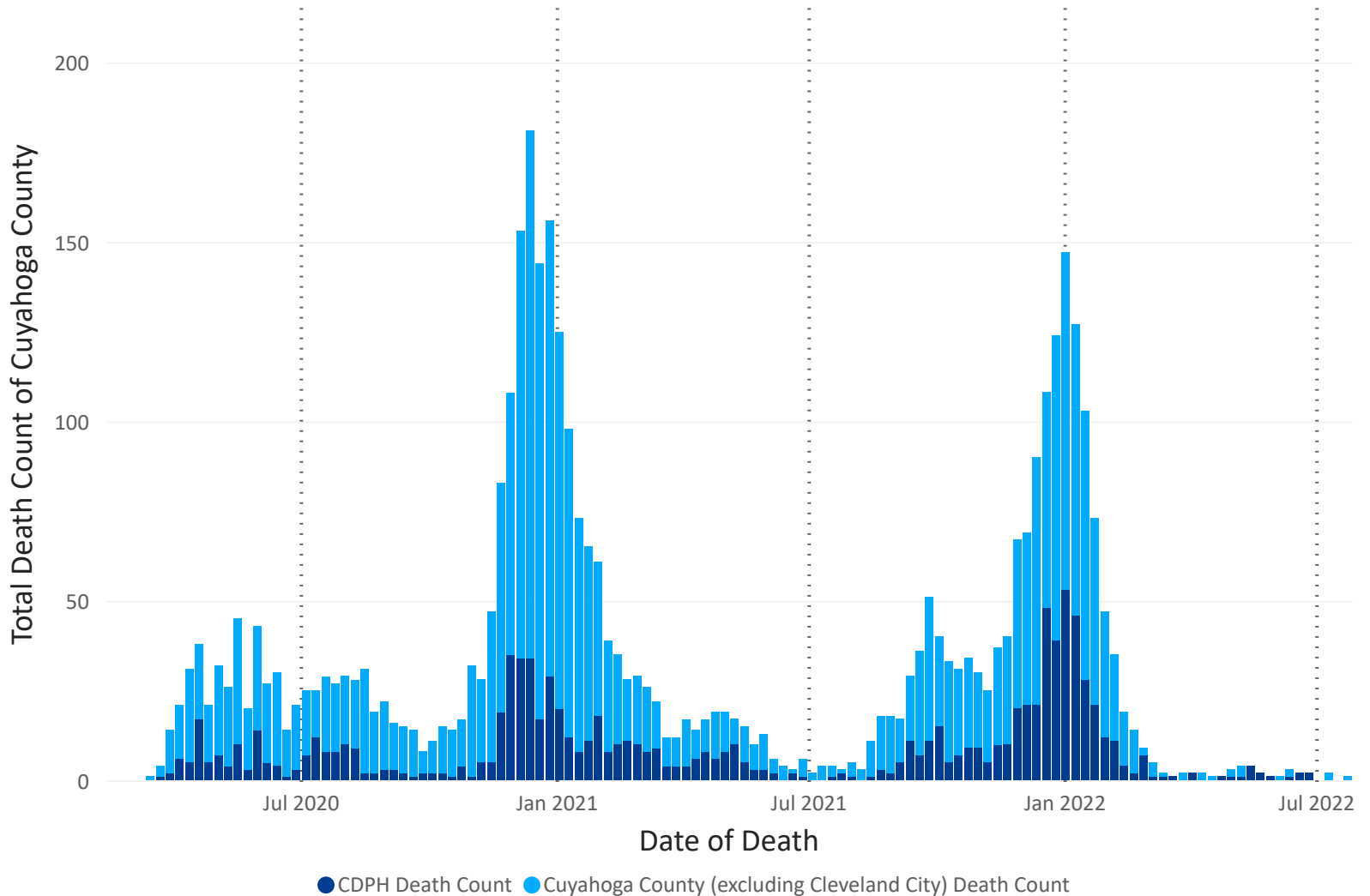

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Disclaimers

The Cuyahoga County numbers are approximate and have been populated using the DataOhio Portal.

Case Definitions: Confirmed: Meets confirmatory laboratory evidence. NOTE: People with no symptoms and with a confirmatory positive test are reportable as confirmed cases. **Probable:** 1} Does not have a confirmatory positive test but meets symptom(s) criteria **AND** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2. 2} Has a positive antigen test **AND** was reported on or after 11/1/2020. (For reports received prior to 11/1/2020: Has a positive antigen test **AND** either meets symptom(s) criteria **OR** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2). 3} No confirmatory positive test for but SARS-CoV-2 is listed on the death certificate as a cause of death.

Metadata

This data report reflects the period starting from February 15, 2020 through July 30, 2022 for the City of Cleveland, Ohio.

Total Cases represent confirmed and probable cases.

Cleveland City data and Cuyahoga County data are compiled on August 2, 2022 using the DataOhio Portal.

Population and demographic data are from the US Census Bureau's 2020 estimates.

Data is preliminary and subject to change as more information is gained.

There may be a delay in reporting.

Data is reported by test date. If test date is unknown, date reported is used as a substitute for the test date. The number of cases can vary based on date used for analysis.
