1. Cleveland COVID-19 cases increased during the week of July 31st with 781 new

cases and a rate of 204 new cases per 100,000 residents. The weekly rate of new cases has been stable over the course of the last three weeks. Mitigation measures are now more important that ever in order drive the number of new cases down word.

2. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Cuyahoga County continues to have a COVID-19 Community Level of high as of August 4th. Cases across Ohio have been decreasing over the last 3 weeks, though many counties still have a high Community Level. Consider mitigation measures such as masking in public or holding gatherings outdoors whenever possible in order the minimize community spread.

- 3. This past week, 294 residents received their first COVID-19 vaccine. Overall, 48.8% of Cleveland residents have completed a primary vaccination series (two doses of Moderna or Pfizer-BioNTech OR one dose of Johnson & Johnson) and 24.3% received their booster shot. Receiving all recommended doses of the vaccine ensures that you have the best protection against severe illness, hospitalization, and death. Adults ages 50 and older are eligible for a second booster dose.
- 4. COVID-19 transmission is occurring most among younger Cleveland residents. More than 60% of new cases were among residents under 50 years old while less than 25% of this demographic received a booster shot. CDPH recommends that all Cleveland residents are up-to-date with vaccination, including boosters.
- 5. CDPH is now offering COVID-19 vaccinations for children ages 6 months and up at both J. Glen and McCafferty Health Centers. Starting your child's vaccination series now can ensure they have the best protection against COVID-19 when they return to school in the fall. **Vaccine data were exported from the DataOhio Portal on August 9, 2022. Vaccination summaries include vaccinations administered to Cleveland residents by any supplier. In CDPH data reporting, individuals are counted in every group of which they meet the criteria. For example, a Cleveland resident who has completed a primary series and received a booster will be included in the counts of each group. Please note, the criteria to have "Completed a Primary Series" differs for individuals who are moderately to severely immunocompromised.







Figure 4. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Gender (Jul 31, 2022 - Aug 06, 2022) (based on 780 cases)





Figure 5. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Gender (Jul 10, 2022 - Aug 06, 2022) (based on 3,054 cases)











Figure 9. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Ethnicity (Jul 10, 2022 - Aug 06, 2022) (based on 3,064 cases)










Demographics of Cleveland Residents who have received any dose of vaccine through August 6, 2022






% of Cleveland Residents Vaccinated per Age Group







Number of Vaccinated Cleveland Residents by Race (based on 202,955 residents)




Demographics of Cleveland Residents who received a booster dose through August 6, 2022








Demographics of Cleveland Residents who received a booster dose through August 6, 2022




Number of Boosted Cleveland Residents by Race (based on 75,992 residents)























Disclaimers

The Cuyahoga County numbers are approximate and have been populated using the DataOhio Portal.

<u>Case Definitions:</u> Confirmed: Meets confirmatory laboratory evidence. NOTE: People with no symptoms and with a confirmatory positive test are reportable as confirmed cases. **Probable:** 1} Does not have a confirmatory positive test but meets symptom(s) criteria **AND** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2. 2} Has a positive antigen test **AND** was reported on or after 11/1/2020. (For reports received prior to 11/1/2020: Has a positive antigen test **AND** either meets symptom(s) criteria **OR** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2). 3}No confirmatory positive test for but SARS-CoV-2 is listed on the death certificate as a cause of death.

Metadata

This data report reflects the period starting from February 15, 2020 through August 6, 2022 for the City of Cleveland, Ohio.

Total Cases represent confirmed and probable cases.

Cleveland City data and Cuyahoga County data are compiled on August 9, 2022 using the DataOhio Portal.

Population and demographic data are from the US Census Bureau's 2020 estimates.

Data is preliminary and subject to change as more information is gained.

There may be a delay in reporting.

Data is reported by test date. If test date is unknown, date reported is used as a substitute for the test date. The number of cases can vary based on date used for analysis.
