### **What Matters Most**

- 1. Cleveland COVID-19 cases decreased during the week of August 28th with 602 new cases and a rate of 157 new cases per 100,000 residents. This was significantly lower than the rate in all of Ohio which was 214 new cases per 100,000 residents. The CDC's COVID-19 Community Level for Cuyahoga County moved from *high* to *medium* as of September 1st. CDPH recommends staying up-to-date with COVID-19 vaccination.
- 2. For the 2nd consecutive week, roughly 20% of COVID-19 cases during the week of August 28th were among Cleveland residents under 20 years of age. Cleveland residents under 20 years old have consistently had the lowest rate of vaccination. CDPH is working with administrators in K-12 schools to quickly respond to potential outbreaks and provide guidance on mitigation strategies to reduce the number of cases in this age group.
- 3. Over 165 Cleveland residents completed their primary vaccination series this week. As of September 6th, 56.1% of Cleveland residents have received any dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, 49.4% have completed their primary vaccination series, and 24.4% have received a booster dose. Cleveland has a vaccination goal of having 60% of residents vaccinated for COVID-19. Appointment for adults and children can be made by calling 216-664-2222 or visiting gettheshot.coronavirus.gov.
- 4. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) now recommends the new bivalent COVID-19 boosters from Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna. The Moderna bivalent booster is authorized for use in individuals 18 years of age and older while the Pfizer-BioNTech bivalent booster is authorized for use in individuals 12 years of age and older. The new boosters provide protection against the Omicron subvariants in addition to the original strain. These new boosters are now available at all CDPH COVID vaccine clinics.
- 5. Remember the steps to take if you test positive for COVID-19. Regardless of vaccination status, if you test positive you should immediately self-isolate away from others for five days. Day 0 of isolation is the first day you had symptoms or the day you tested positive if you did not have symptoms. If you had symptoms, you can end isolation after day five if you are fever free for 24 hours and if your symptoms are improving. You should wear a mask for the next five days.

\*\*Vaccine data were exported from the DataOhio Portal on September 6, 2022. Vaccination summaries include vaccinations administered to Cleveland residents by any supplier. In CDPH data reporting, individuals are counted in every group of which they meet the criteria. For example, a Cleveland resident who has completed a primary series and received a booster will be included in the counts of each group. Please note, the criteria to have "Completed a Primary Series" differs for individuals who are moderately to severely immunocompromised.








Figure 4. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Gender (Aug 28, 2022 - Sep 03, 2022) (based on 595 cases)





Figure 5. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Gender (Aug 07, 2022 - Sep 03, 2022) (based on 2,617 cases)











Figure 9. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Ethnicity (Aug 07, 2022 - Sep 03, 2022) (based on 2,629 cases)













Number of Vaccinated Cleveland Residents by Race (based on 208,644 residents)












# Demographics of Cleveland Residents who received a booster dose through September 3, 2022




# Number of Boosted Cleveland Residents by Race (based on 76,076 residents)























### **Disclaimers**

The Cuyahoga County numbers are approximate and have been populated using the DataOhio Portal.

<u>Case Definitions:</u> Confirmed: Meets confirmatory laboratory evidence. NOTE: People with no symptoms and with a confirmatory positive test are reportable as confirmed cases. **Probable:** 1} Does not have a confirmatory positive test but meets symptom(s) criteria **AND** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2. 2} Has a positive antigen test **AND** was reported on or after 11/1/2020. (For reports received prior to 11/1/2020: Has a positive antigen test **AND** either meets symptom(s) criteria **OR** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2). 3}No confirmatory positive test for but SARS-CoV-2 is listed on the death certificate as a cause of death.

#### Metadata

This data report reflects the period starting from February 15, 2020 through September 3, 2022 for the City of Cleveland, Ohio.

Total Cases represent confirmed and probable cases.

Cleveland City data and Cuyahoga County data are compiled on September 6, 2022 using the DataOhio Portal.

Population and demographic data are from the US Census Bureau's 2020 estimates.

Data is preliminary and subject to change as more information is gained.

There may be a delay in reporting.

Data is reported by test date. If test date is unknown, date reported is used as a substitute for the test date. The number of cases can vary based on date used for analysis.
