What Matters Most

- 1. Cleveland COVID-19 cases held stable during the week of November 13th with 362 new cases and a rate of 94 new cases per 100,000 residents. Northeast Ohio maintains a COVID-19 Community Level of "Medium" while the COVID-19 activity in appears to be increasing in neighboring counties as of November 24th with Portage and Medina now being "High". The true incidence is likely higher due to positive home tests throughout the state that may not be reported to the health department.
- 2. A higher percentage of cases this reporting week were among younger Cleveland residents. Roughly 60% of COVID-19 cases were among residents 50 years of age and younger compared to 53% during the last reporting week. Older residents and those with comorbidities remain at higher risk for severe cases and hospitalization.
- 3. 153 Cleveland residents received their first COVID-19 shot this week over the past two weeks. As of November 29th, 57.2% of Cleveland residents have received any dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, 50.2% have completed their primary vaccination series, and 25.5% have received a booster dose. Cleveland residents that already completed a primary vaccination series are also receiving the bivalent booster shots. Appointments for adults and children can be made by calling 216-664-2222 or visiting gettheshot.coronavirus.gov. COVID-19 and flu can be given at the same visit.
- 4. There were 8 COVID-19 hospitals this reporting week; however, hospitals have begun to experience additional strain due to the expected increase in flu and RSV intensity during the fall and winter season. RSV and flu-associated hospitalizations indicate that activity for both infections is far higher than it has been in the last two years. All three of these are respiratory viruses where infection spread can be reduced with hand washing, cleaning contaminated surfaces, and practicing proper "respiratory etiquette". This entails covering your month when you cough and staying home if you are ill until you are fever-free and symptoms are improving.

**Vaccine data were exported from the DataOhio Portal on November 29, 2022. Vaccination summaries include vaccinations administered to Cleveland residents by any supplier. In CDPH data reporting, individuals are counted in every group of which they meet the criteria. For example, a Cleveland resident who has completed a primary series and received a booster will be included in the counts of each group. Please note, the criteria to have "Completed a Primary Series" differs for individuals who are moderately to severely immunocompromised.







Figure 4. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Gender (Nov 20, 2022 - Nov 26, 2022) (based on 361 cases)





Figure 5. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Gender (Oct 30, 2022 - Nov 26, 2022) (based on 1,464 cases)











Figure 9. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Ethnicity (Oct 30, 2022 - Nov 26, 2022) (based on 1,469 cases)







Demographics of Cleveland Residents who have received any dose of vaccine through November 26, 2022








Demographics of Cleveland Residents who have received any dose of vaccine through November 26, 2022




Number of Vaccinated Cleveland Residents by Race (based on 212,571 residents)




Demographics of Cleveland Residents who received a booster dose through November 26, 2022



























Disclaimers

The Cuyahoga County numbers are approximate and have been populated using the DataOhio Portal.

<u>Case Definitions:</u> Confirmed: Meets confirmatory laboratory evidence. NOTE: People with no symptoms and with a confirmatory positive test are reportable as confirmed cases. **Probable:** 1} Does not have a confirmatory positive test but meets symptom(s) criteria **AND** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2. 2} Has a positive antigen test **AND** was reported on or after 11/1/2020. (For reports received prior to 11/1/2020: Has a positive antigen test **AND** either meets symptom(s) criteria **OR** has had close contact with someone who has a confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2). 3}No confirmatory positive test for but SARS-CoV-2 is listed on the death certificate as a cause of death.

Metadata

This data report reflects the period starting from February 15, 2020 through November 26, 2022 for the City of Cleveland, Ohio.

Total Cases represent confirmed and probable cases.

Cleveland City data and Cuyahoga County data are compiled on November 29, 2022 using the DataOhio Portal.

Population and demographic data are from the US Census Bureau's 2020 estimates.

Data is preliminary and subject to change.

There may be a delay in reporting.

Data is reported by test date. If test date is unknown, date reported is used as a substitute for the test date. The number of cases can vary based on date used for analysis.
