Cleveland Department of Public Health 75 Erieview Plaza, Floor 3 Cleveland, Ohio 44114 Office: 216-420-7743 Fax: 216-664-6159 The purpose of the COVID-19 Watch is to summarize the coronavirus surveillance and vaccine uptake in the City of Cleveland, Ohio. This report uses data available through March 25, 2023. Data on COVID-19 case demographics focus on the last four full weeks prior to publication (January 29 - March 25, 2023).

What Matters Most

- 1. Cleveland COVID-19 activity decreased during the month of February with an average 7-day incidence rate of 63 new cases per 100,000 residents. This is comparable to state-wide COVID-19 activity during the same time frame which, averaged a 7-day incidence rate of 43 new cases per 100,000 residents. Locally and state-wide, the week-to-week COVID-19 incidence for the past 4 weeks has decreased. With the availability of home tests and lack of self-reporting to the health department, the true incidence is likely higher.
- 2. As of March 25th, Cuyahoga County continues to have a COVID-19 Community Level of "low". While COVID-19 continues to circulate in the community fewer people are experiencing severe illness or require hospitalization. At a low Community Level, CDC recommends that residents stay up-to-date with COVID-19 vaccines, including recommended booster doses.
- 3. 466 residents received their first COVID-19 vaccine during the month of March. As of March 28th, 57.9% of Cleveland residents have received any dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, 50.8% have completed their primary vaccination series, and 26.2% have received a booster dose. Appointments for adults and children can be made visiting gettheshot.coronavirus.gov.
- 4. March 11th marked the three-year anniversary of the World Health Organization declaring the COVID-19 outbreak a pandemic. Since then measures for COVID-19 prevention, treatment, and vaccination have evolved rapidly and currently the majority of US counties have a low COVID-19 Community Level. With the acute phase of the pandemic coming to an end, health experts anticipate shifting COVID-19 efforts to understand and treat long COVID.







Figure 2. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Age (Feb 26, 2023 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 972 cases)





Figure 3. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Age (Feb 26, 2023 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 972 cases)

Figure 4. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Gender (Feb 26, 2023 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 970 cases)





Figure 5. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Gender (Feb 26, 2023 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 970 cases)

Figure 6. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Cases by Race (Feb 26, 2023 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 919 cases)





Figure 7. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Race (Feb 26, 2023 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 919 cases)





Figure 9. COVID-19 Cases in City of Cleveland by Ethnicity (Feb 26, 2023 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 972 cases)





% of Cleveland Residents Vaccinated per Age Group




% of Cleveland Residents Boosted by Age Group







% of Cleveland Residents Vaccinated per Race Population




% of Cleveland Residents Boosted per Race Population







Figure 11. City of Cleveland COVID-19 Hospitalizations by Demographics (Feb 15, 2020 - Mar 25, 2023) (based on 6,057 cases)













By Gender







MetaData

The Cuyahoga County numbers are approximate and have been populated using the DataOhio Portal.

This data report reflects the period starting from February 15, 2020 through March 25, 2023 for the City of Cleveland, Ohio.

Total Cases represent confirmed and probable cases.

Cleveland City data and Cuyahoga County data are compiled on March 28, 2023 using the DataOhio Portal.

Population and demographic data are from the US Census Bureau's 2020 estimates.

Data is preliminary and subject to change.

There may be a delay in reporting.

Data is reported by test date. If test date is unknown, the date a case is reported to Ohio Department of Health is used as a substitute for the test date. The number of cases can vary based on dates used for analysis.
